Official Application

ELIGIBILITY

The Art Department encourages all exhibitors to submit their BEST works. The emphasis is on ORIGINALITY and SKILL. No photocopies, Original computer-generated work may be entered in Division: Drawing & Other Media, Class #12.

ENTRY RULES

1. Exhibitors must register in person at 2nd Saturday events, or can drop off registration form to Hometown Outfitters, or entries will be accepted on Sept. 21st at the fairgrounds between 10AM-5PM
2. Exhibits must have your name, and category listed somewhere on or next to art.
3. Each exhibitor submitting entries to the Fair will need to have an exhibitor ID and enter their exhibits under their name.
4. An exhibitor may enter more than class.

JUDGING

5. Exhibitors may enter up to 4 art works and/or 4 poetry entries. These works may be entered in the same or different Lots.
6. Adult entries must be framed and wired for hanging. Youth work may be framed and wired, matted or mounted.
7. Exhibitors will be responsible that exhibits are entered in the right Division and Class.
8. Lewis County Fair Board will NOT be responsible for theft or breakage of any entry.

10. JUDGING 1. Awards will be marked 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and Best of Show, according to the merits of the exhibit. The Judge may disqualify or award 1st, 2nd, or 3rd premiums at his/her discretion. The Judge shall disqualify or transfer to the correct Division or Class (at his/her discretion) any exhibit which is not a true representative of the Division or Class in which it is entered.

12. The Judge may disqualify any exhibit not of show quality. The Fair Board reserves the right to reduce premiums in each class if the awards exceed the amount allocated. Judge may disqualify or award 1st, 2nd, or 3rd premiums at his/her discretion.
